National workshop on Statistical Analysis for Pharmaceutical Research with MS-EXCEL



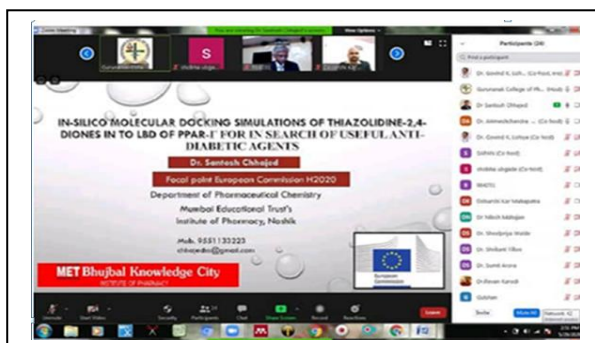

“Hands on Training for Sophisticated Instruments”

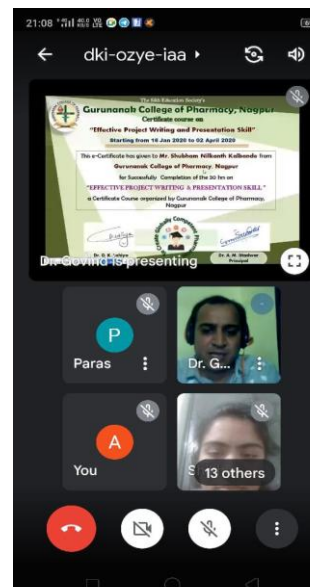
