Understanding the basis of computer-aided drug design/development (CADD) is a vital part of the training of students specializing in medicinal chemistry, pharmaceutics, pharmacology, or pharmacy. The ability to select a target, explore the interactions between protein and ligand, design small molecule drug candidates and evaluate their potential in silico provides students with a crucial skill-set for a successful career as medicinal chemists. This program will provide complete workflow, from the initial downloading and evaluation of a target protein structure from the PDB, through searching databases for candidate structures, designing and inputting drug candidates, molecular docking experiments, evaluation of the results and subsequent rounds of molecular redesign. After competing this program students can undertake a CADD project and prepare the molecules in the laboratory designed by them.


