Defeat is only a state of mind, an interpretation of one's own performance. Being licked is valuable, if we learn lessons from it. My Guru used to say: "Be constructively self-critical. Don't run away from inadequacies. Be a real professional and perform your best. Seek out faults and weaknesses and correct them. Albert Hubbard said: "A failure is a man who has blundered but is not able to cash-in on the experience".

Equation with life to make it worth living requires lot of adjustment and flexibility. In the African novel Matigari by NGUGI, the author says: "The true seeker of real justice never tires. A farmer does not stop planting seeds just because of the failure of one crop. Success is born of trying and trying again and again.
